The AFFA 2024's theme was an important initiative proposed Vietnam Prime Minister Pham Minh Chinh at the 43rd ASEAN Summit last September. It aimed at creating a common platform for ASEAN member states as well as partner countries and ASEAN people to contribute to promoting and shaping the bloc's development path. This regional event attracted nearly 500 delegates representing governments, diplomatic corps and business communities.

Microsoft announced a commitment to equip 2.5 million people in member states of ASEAN with AI skills by 2025. The skilling initiatives will be implemented in partnership with governments, nonprofit and corporate organizations, and communities across Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam. The skilling commitment will focus on four areas: building an inclusive, AI-ready workforce; bridging the cybersecurity talent gap; enhancing developers' AI skills; and empowering nonprofit organizations to maximize their social impact.

COUNTRY WATCH: MALAYSIA IS EMERGING AS A DATA CENTER POWERHOUSE AMID BOOMING DEMAND FROM AI COPYRIGHT ARTICLE): BY DYLAN BUTTS, JUNE 16, 2024

Malaysia is becoming the data center powerhouse of Southeast Asia and the Continent more broadly as demand surges for cloud computing and artificial intelligence. Over the past few years, the country has attracted billions of dollars in data center investments, including from tech giants like Google, Nvidia and Microsoft. Much of the investments have been in the small city of Johor Bahru, located on the border with Singapore. Johor Bahru was named as the fastest growing market within Southeast Asia in DC Byte's 2024 Global Data Center Index.
